

# It's time to move into One Home for Sites™

IQVIA One Home for Sites™ is the only solution that unifies and simplifies site operations, acting as a centralized hub to connect, streamline, and organize all key systems needed to manage multiple clinical trials at once. Self registration and self-administration capabilities are available to sites for free. You can add the studies, systems, tasks, study contacts and your study teammates even if the sponsor of those studies or its designated CRO has not yet adopted One Home.

One Home is a vendor-neutral, sponsor-neutral, minimalistic technology platform that provides single sign-on across all your trials. Release 2.0 has made self-registration and self-administration capabilities available for sites. You can add the studies, systems and tasks your site is working on, even if the sponsor of those studies or its designated CRO has not yet adopted One Home.

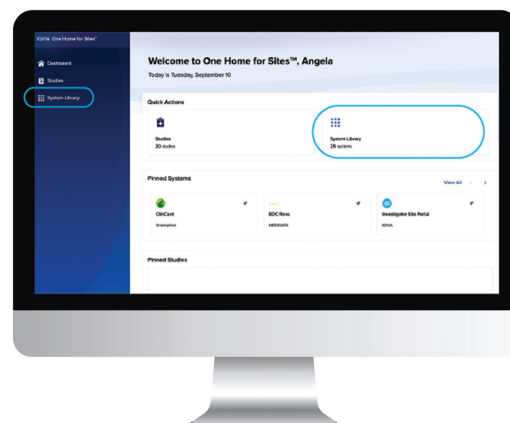
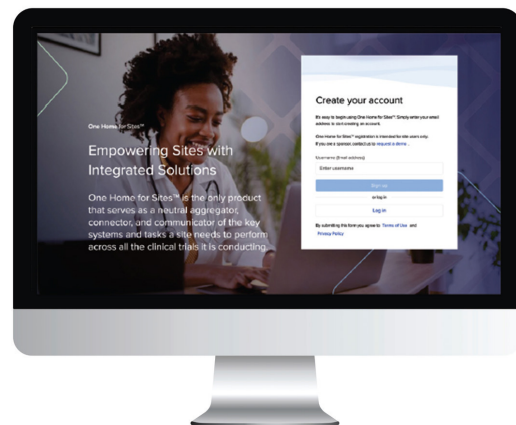
One Home Single Sign-On (SSO) is based on email address and will connect you to other systems where you have a matching email address.

Go to <https://onehome.clintech.iqvia.com/> and enter your most frequently used email address. If you already have access to some of IQVIA's systems, you can use the same credentials to access One Home. If you have never accessed IQVIA's systems with that email address, you can create a new account.

**Important note: Please do not enter any patient information into the One Home platform**

## Using the SSO System Library

- **What is it?** SSO access to multiple clinical technology systems.
- **Why would I use it?** To reduce the number of usernames and passwords you need to reference for accessing these clinical technology systems.
- **How do I use it?** There are two ways to access the SSO System Library.
  - » Via the Quick Links section on your Dashboard.
  - » Via the dark blue navigation panel on the left side of the page.



- **Notes and help tips:**

- » You can pin the systems you use frequently. These pinned systems will be added to your One Home dashboard.
- » New vendors are added to the System Library on a regular basis. There will be a “New” tag on recently added systems.
- » Single Sign-on works for systems you have authorization to use. If you do not have access to certain systems, you will receive an unauthorized user message. You will need to contact the specific vendor directly, e.g., Medidata, Greenphire, etc., or follow its specific system access request process.

## Adding studies (including Systems, Tasks, Links, Study Contacts, My Team)

- **What is it?** Add the studies you and your team are conducting. These studies do not have to be specific to IQVIA — they can be from any sponsor or CRO.
- **Why would I use it?** To create a shared, study-specific space to know and access a study’s systems and portals, collaborate on study tasks, and add useful links and study contacts that help you and your team more efficiently manage your studies.
- **How do I use it?** Once you add your studies, you can start to connect and/or manually add systems to those studies. Under the My Team tab, you can invite teammates and create a shared study space to manage study-related tasks, add useful links and study contacts for your whole team to reference.
- **Notes and help tips:**
  - » For the optimal SSO experience, we always recommend you connect systems to studies from the System Library and only manually add a system if it does not yet exist there.
  - » Once you add teammates, they will receive an invitation email. Anyone on the team can connect or add a system/portal, add and complete tasks, and add useful links and study contacts. If you have been invited by a teammate, you will have access to everything that has already been setup for that study.
- If you have an account in IQVIA Profiles (formerly DrugDev), then you will see a list of studies from your profile that you can select and add.

**Important note: Everything added to a study is shared among all teammates included on the “My Team” tab. Please be mindful not to enter information that may unblind a teammate. Anything added to or deleted from a study is done so for all teammates.**
